

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

**SANDIA NATIONAL LABORATORIES
OF ALBUQUERQUE NEW MEXICO USA**

and

**INDEPENDENT DEVELOPMENT TRUST
CAPE TOWN, REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA**

25 August 1995

The Sandia National Laboratories of Albuquerque New Mexico USA on the one hand and the Independent Development Trust (IDT) on the other hand have reached the following understanding:

ARTICLE 1

The Independent Development Trust (IDT) plays a primary role in the implementation of the basic needs program for health and rural development in support of the Reconstruction and Development Program (RDP), is managing a nation-wide program to electrify rural clinics and other rural institutions. The IDT utilises grant funding for the capital equipment, provides facilitation with local communities and training for the development of skills in maintenance of systems.

To support the efforts of the IDT in its clinics and rural institution electrification Sandia National Laboratories will provide the following:

- A) Co-funding of the IDT model clinic electrification program, by an amount and to conditions to be mutually agreed upon.
- B) Technical assistance as agreed to by mutual consent.

ARTICLE II

In order to maximize the benefits of the assistance provided by Sandia in ARTICLE I above, the IDT will provide the following:

- A) Project management of the specific funds intended for the model clinic program.
- B) Incorporation of the model clinic project into the IDT clinic electrification program
- C) Facilitation of the program by field staff where necessary.


