

AGREEMENT TO EXTEND ANNEX II
TO THE PROTOCOL FOR COOPERATION IN THE FIELDS OF
ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND RENEWABLE ENERGY
TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT AND UTILIZATION
FOR COOPERATIVE ACTIVITIES IN
WIND DEVELOPMENT IN CHINA
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
THE STATE POWER CORPORATION OF CHINA

The Department of Energy of the United States of America (USDOE) and the State Power Corporation of China (SP), hereinafter referred to as (“the Parties”);

Noting that USDOE and the State Science and Technology Commission of the People’s Republic of China (SSTC) signed the Protocol for Cooperation in the Fields of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Technology Development and Utilization (hereinafter referred to as “the Protocol”), on February 23, 1995;

Noting that the Protocol, including its Annexes, is subject to the Agreement between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the People’s Republic of China on Cooperation in Science and Technology, signed at Washington, on January 31, 1979, as amended and extended, hereinafter referred to as “the Umbrella Agreement”;

Noting that the Protocol was amended on February 1, 1999, to reflect the transfer of functions from the SSTC to the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) of the People’s Republic of China, and extended for a five year period, effective from February 23, 2000;

Noting that the Annex II was amended on June 15, 2000, to reflect the transfer functions from the Ministry of Electric Power (MOEP) of the People’s Republic of China to the State Power Corporation of China, and to facilitate the development and use of wind hybrid electric power equipment technology in the People’s Republic of China; and

Noting that the Parties have a strong desire to continue to cooperate in the areas of wind energy development in China for their mutual benefit;

The Parties have agreed as follows:

1. Annex II is hereby extended for a five year period, effective from October 25, 2001, and shall remain in force for five years, or until termination of the Protocol, whichever occurs first. This Annex may be further amended or extended by mutual written agreement of the Parties.
2. At the discretion of either Party, this Annex may be terminated upon six (6) months advance notice in writing to the other Party.
