

**PROTOCOL EXTENDING THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
THE FEDERAL NUCLEAR AND RADIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY OF RUSSIA
TO COOPERATE
ON NATIONAL PROTECTION, CONTROL AND ACCOUNTING OF NUCLEAR
MATERIALS**

The Department of Energy of the United States of America and the Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia;

Recognizing that the Agreement between the Department of Energy of the United States of America and the Federal Nuclear and Radiation Safety Authority of Russia; signed in June 30, 1995, (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement") will terminate on June 30, 2000:

Acting pursuant to Article VI of the Agreement;

Have agreed as follows;

ARTICLE I

The term of the Agreement will be extended for five years until June 30, 2005, unless terminated earlier in accordance with Article VI of the Agreement.

ARTICLE II

This Protocol will enter into force on June 30, 2000.
