

**STATEMENT OF INTENT
BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY
OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF BEIJING
OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA
CONCERNING CLEAN ENERGY TECHNOLOGIES**

The Department of Energy of the United States of America and the Municipality of Beijing (MOB) of the People's Republic of China (PRC), hereinafter the "Participants,"

Noting the mutual interest of their respective countries in the development and utilization of clean energy technologies;

Noting that many agencies of the United States Government are engaged in a broad range of cooperative activities of mutual interest with ministries and other instrumentalities of the PRC in areas such as: energy, environment, agriculture, transportation, market development, business planning and financing; and


Noting that the MOB will host the 2008 Summer Olympic Games, and in preparation seeks to improve Beijing's environmental quality through the utilization of clean, efficient and sustainable technologies in urban energy planning, transportation, industry and manufacturing, infrastructure development, electric supply and distributed generation, air quality improvement, water and sewage treatment, and forestry;

State their intentions as follows:

- 1) The Participants propose to create a framework for collaboration in order to improve the environmental quality of Beijing, with a focus on assisting MOB to develop clean energy technologies, and energy and environmental policies in preparation for the 2008 Summer Olympic Games.
- 2) The Participants anticipate that the activities conducted under their collaborative framework will help create market opportunities for suppliers of clean energy products and services in both Participants' countries, encourage U.S. business investments and other participation in clean energy projects in China, and promote and accelerate the commercialization of clean energy in the PRC.
